Kia ora Whanau

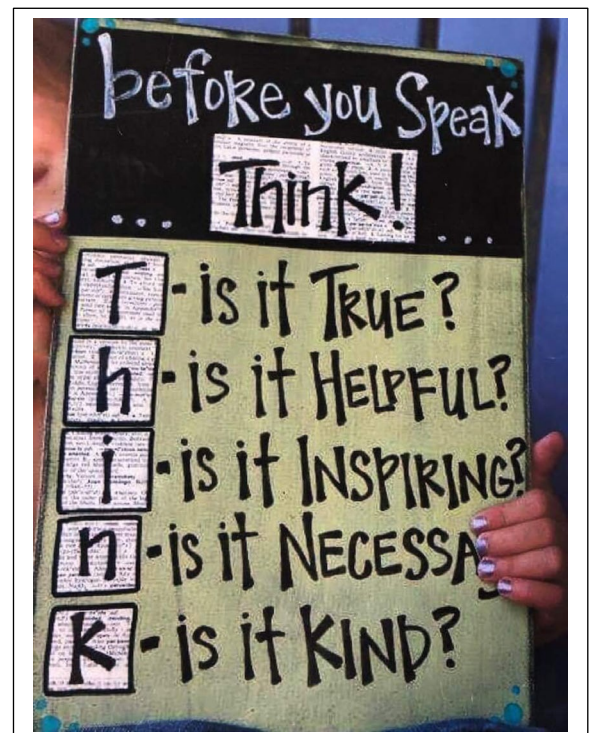
A huge vote of thanks to you all for your continued support of our wonderful children. We are blessed with such curious, excited learners who are well served by our tremendous staff.

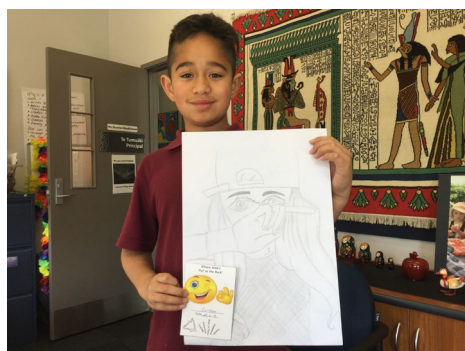

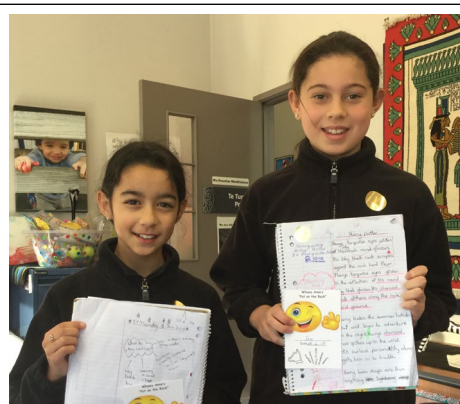

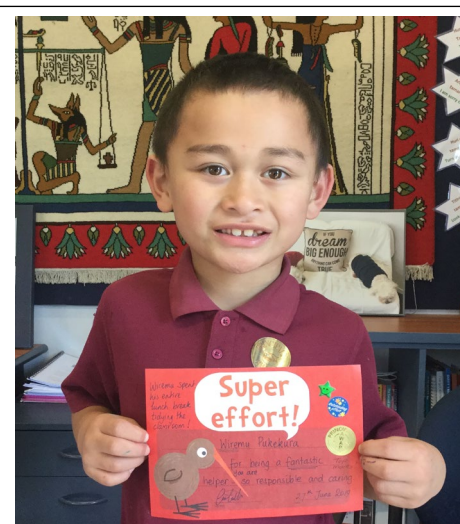
