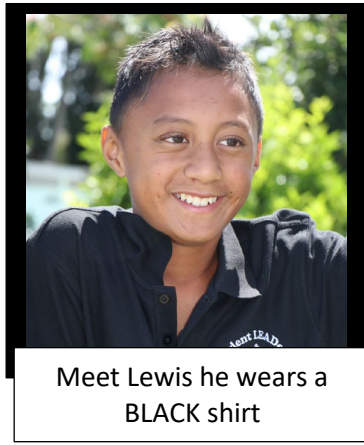

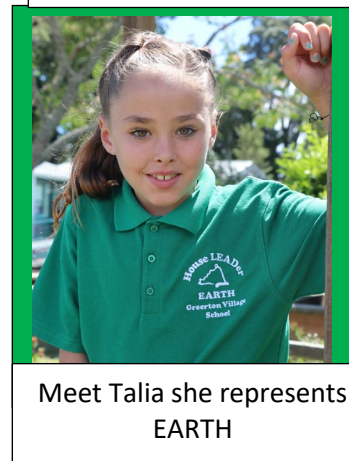

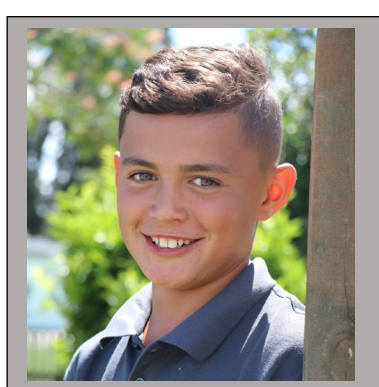

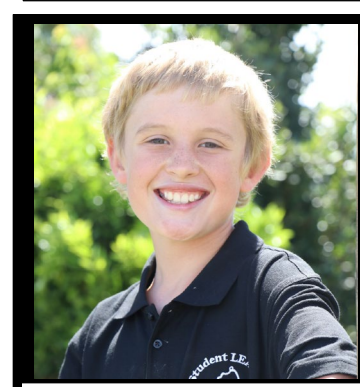

That is **Not Nice**

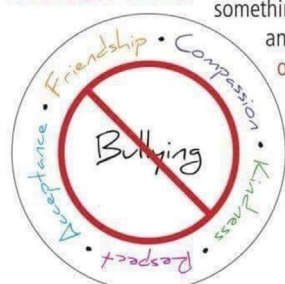
## MEAN
