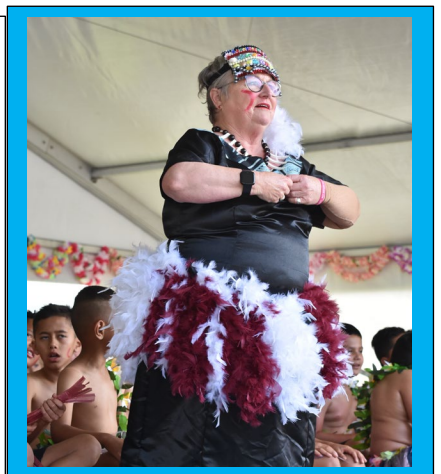

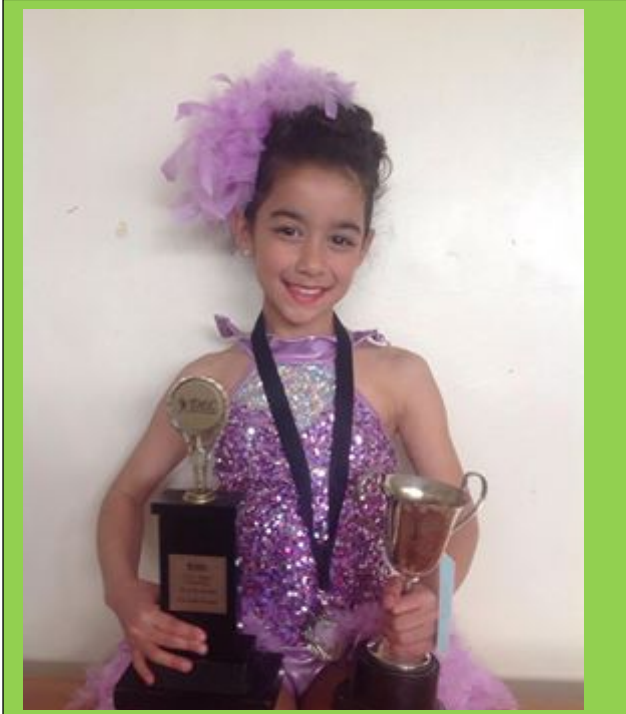
CELEBRATIONS AT GVS
